## TIPS AND NETIQUETTE FOR ZOOM WEBINARS

- Use the most reliable source of internet available:
  - If possible, connect directly to your internet modem and ask others in your household to avoid internet use
  - If unable to directly connect, position yourself as close to your Wi-Fi router as reasonably possible
  - If home Wi-Fi is unstable, consider using a mobile data hotspot (if more reliable)
- Dress for the webinar in the way you would for an in-person conference
- Join early–AT LEAST 5 minutes before the start of the conference
